

STUDENTS' ORGANIZATION

The Student Council is formed by the 4 House Captains. One is the President and the other ones are the Vice-President, the Treasurer and the Secretary. The House Secretaries/Vice-Captains are the Fire-marshals.

Houses become the student body organization with the aim of providing an inclusive community actively involved in school life

Posts of responsibility by election:

House Captain election

House Secretary election

Houses aims

- Decide on name, flag, colour, within a topic (connected to the Quinta, Barcarena, etc.)
- Define tasks and responsibilities within the house and between houses
- Identify and address problems of individuals or groups
- Fund raising
- The Student Council meets every week with the School Principal who will then report back to the ELT
- Organizing and actively participate in school events
- Perform duties such as: inside and outside maintenance, recycling, vegetable garden, fire procedures, flood prevention, etc.
- Keep a log book of meetings and reflections on the outcomes of house activities
- Represent the house at school
- Organize a 20min assembly once a term
- Establish the house point system/term.

Yearly:

Meeting 1: a teacher to explain what the houses are, election procedures, name, flag and colour, etc
Between Meeting 1 and 2 Campaigns with speakers corner lunch/breaks

Meeting 2: Elections

From here onwards the Student Council and Houses take full responsibility of their own development.
